The City of Lawndale invites interested residents to apply for appointment to the Lawndale Cable Commission. This five-member commission serves the community in the following ways:

- Makes recommendations regarding community cable television programming
- Approves Cable Commission grants for community access productions
- Develops a promotion plan to enhance channel usage and viewership
- Reviews the effectiveness of outreach efforts
- Creates improved interest in local events, people, and issues
- Provides residents, businesses and organizations an opportunity to produce and participate in community television
- Encourages the education of students in community television programming and production
- Produces cable television productions of interest to the community
- Assesses the adequacy of community access equipment and facilities

Lawndale cable commissioners meet on the fourth Thursday of each even-numbered month and receive a stipend for each meeting attended. The successful applicant will serve a term beginning immediately upon appointment by the mayor and City Council and ending on February 28, 2019.

To qualify for appointment, you must have been a resident of the city of Lawndale for at least 30 days prior to submitting a written application. Applications are available at City Hall, 14717 Burin Avenue, or on the city's website [www.lawndalecity.org](http://www.lawndalecity.org), and will be accepted by the city clerk department until the position is filled.
