The City of Lawndale is inviting interested residents to apply for appointment to the Lawndale Planning Commission. The duties and responsibilities of this five-member commission include the following:

- Recommending plans for the regulation of the future growth, development and beautification of the city in respect to its public and private buildings and works, streets, parks, grounds and vacant lots
- Recommending plans consistent with the future growth and development of the city, in order to secure sanitation, proper service of all public utilities, shipping and transportation facilities
- Making recommendations with reference to the location of any proposed buildings, structures or works
- Making recommendations to the City Council regarding tentative maps of proposed subdivisions of land, advise the City Council with respect to the design and improvement of proposed subdivisions
- Doing such other things as shall be necessary to carry out the provisions of the Lawndale Municipal Code and the provisions of the Conservation and Planning Act of the state

To qualify for appointment, you must be at least 18 years of age and must have been a resident of Lawndale for at least 30 consecutive days prior to submitting the application for appointment. Applications are available at Lawndale City Hall, 14717 Burin Avenue, and on the City's website, [www.lawndalecity.org](http://www.lawndalecity.org). Applications must be submitted to the City Clerk's Department and will be accepted until the position is filled.
