NOTICE OF UNANTICIPATED VACANCY SENIOR CITIZEN ADVISORY COMMITTEE

The City of Lawndale is inviting interested persons to apply for appointment to fill an unanticipated vacancy on the Senior Citizen Advisory Committee. The Mayor and City Council will consider the appointment of four new members to serve until February 28, 2021.

The primary function of this 12-member committee is to advise the Parks, Recreation and Social Services Commission on matters relating to senior citizen programs and needs in the City of Lawndale.

To qualify for appointment, you must be 55 years of age or older. Committee members must:

- (a) reside within the city of Lawndale; or
- (b) participate in the City's senior citizen program and reside within any of those cities commonly known as the South Bay Cities; specifically, the cities of Carson, El Segundo, Gardena, Hawthorne, Hermosa Beach, Inglewood, Lomita, Manhattan Beach, Palos Verdes Estates, Rancho Palos Verdes, Redondo Beach, Rolling Hills, Rolling Hills Estates, or Torrance; or
- (c) participate in the City's senior citizen program and reside within the unincorporated portion of Los Angeles County known as El Camino Village.

Applications are available at Lawndale City Hall, 14717 Burin Avenue, at the Community Center, 14701 Burin Avenue, and on the city's website, www.lawndalecity.org. Applications must be submitted to the City Clerk Department and will be accepted until the position is filled.
