

Updated Signs on Vehicles Ordinance

As of November 5, 2015, the City will have new regulations regarding signs on vehicles. According to the new ordinance, it is generally prohibited to park a vehicle on a commercial street (i.e. Inglewood Avenue, Marine Avenue, Prairie Avenue, Manhattan Beach Boulevard, Hawthorne Boulevard, Rosecrans Avenue, Artesia Boulevard and Redondo Beach Boulevard) with a removable sign on it, unless the vehicle is parked within 500 feet of the residence of the owner of the vehicle.

Here are some examples of prohibited signs.



These types of sign can result in a parking citation being issued. There are additional exceptions to the new ordinance, such as vehicles parked with these types of signs for a limited period of time.

The signs shown below would not be regulated by the new ordinance.
