

West Basin offers free water-use assessments and conservation training for restaurants and commercial kitchens. Participants receive training materials and can qualify for free water-saving devices such as:

- Pre-rinse kitchen sprayer
- Water broom
- Faucet aerators
- Faucet flow control valves

** Rebates are available for ice machines and kitchen steamers.*


HOW THE PROGRAM WORKS

The water-use assessment provides restaurants with information of their current water practices and equipment, strategies on how to better conserve water, and free materials to assist management in training their employees to be more water efficient.
