1. Case No. 16-11: City Marijuana Regulations to Address Proposition 64 (Adult Use of Marijuana Act) (Reso. No. 16-07)

Location: Citywide

Applicant: City of Lawndale

Description: A draft ordinance to prohibit: (1) all commercial marijuana uses licensed under the Adult Use of Marijuana Act, (2) the outdoor personal cultivation of marijuana, and (3) the smoking of marijuana in and around public parks and City-owned buildings. It would also enact reasonable regulations for the indoor personal cultivation of marijuana. The project is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act, pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3).
